General Care

Brushing and sweeping dirt away regularly is the simplest method of keeping your rugs clean. You can also shake them out or vacuum, though we recommend vacuuming with the beater bar turned off to prevent excessive wear.

Performance & Indoor/Outdoor

In addition to vacuuming and shaking out regularly, indoor/outdoor rugs may be rinsed with an outdoor hose. If the rug is exposed to excessive water from heavy rain, allow the rug to dry completely to avoid mildew/mold.

Liquid Spills

Blot the affected area with a clean, white towel as soon as possible. Never scrub. If the liquid has dried, brush away any excess debris before blotting the area with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Once the spot is no longer visible, blot away the detergent with a damp cloth. Keep the damp area of the rug off the ground to quicken drying time. Always test colorfastness of the rug before applying detergent.
